1. For what should we ask God if we are lacking it? Will God answer this prayer?
2. With what kind of heart should we ask this from question 2?
3. In your own words, define “double-minded man”. How can being a double-minded person affect your life?
4. What do you suppose could be the “high position” that a brother of low or humble circumstances might could take proper pride in from verse 9?
5. How might a wealthy believer think properly about humiliating trials and circumstances and even rejoice and give thanks for them?
6. God himself does not become tempted nor does he tempt. Does He allow temptation to occur?
7. Explain the progression from temptation to death presented in verses 14 and 15.
8. What is meant by “Father of lights” in verse 17?
9. What is the relationship of “shadow due to change” to the “Father of lights”?
10. How do verses 19-21 challenge you?
11. In light of how you answered question 10, how do verses 22-25 encourage you toward living a lifestyle of true righteousness?
12. How important do you think it is that we guard our tongue?
13. How important do you think it is that we help the needy and keep a good testimony to those who know you?
14. What does this passage tell you about God? How does this aspect of God’s character change your view of self? What should you do in response?
